

ALPHA seminar—First paper

First draft due: September 22

Your job is to interview your assigned faculty member and write a paper that describes her/his research. The paper should be written in a scholarly style, and cover these points:

- Professor's name and main research areas (currently)
- A brief description of some of the research that the professor does.
- Where s/he earned the PhD and name of professor's advisor
- A complete citation (in APA style) to the professor's PhD dissertation.
- A few recent articles, cited in APA style
- Bibliography with the references cited

I repeat, write this like a scholarly paper, *not* a bulleted list of answers to the above points.

If at all possible, write this in \LaTeX and use $\text{bib}\TeX$ (and the `natbib` package, with `\bibliographystyle{newapa}`) to do the references and citations. This should be a rather short paper—one-to-two pages, single-spaced, 12-point, article style. Since it is to be so short, no abstract is needed.

Grading: Inverse grading. . . You write, I comment, you revise, I comments, . . . , until paper is perfect.
